



Easy Spelling Aid



Tool Description

Easy Spelling Aid is an educational app that allows people of all ages to translate and spell simple or complex words. It can translate in several different languages and is easy to use. It is designed to help people with dyslexia or any other learning disorder with their spelling and with translation. It uses the “OpenDyslexic” font, which is recommended for the Dys.

What is the challenge the tool can solve?

Children with specific learning disorders, especially those with dyslexia, often have reading and writing difficulties. They will often need an adult to help them study and understand stories in books. As they tend to mix some letters and sounds, it can be difficult for them to put their ideas down in writing. This also makes learning a new language more challenging for them. Thankfully, there are several tools that can help them get more autonomy, such as the one presented here.

We propose this tool in order to help children with learning disorders to become more autonomous in their use of language and in their learning process. As they often experience difficulties in learning a foreign language, this tool can be of great help for practicing vocabulary and written assignments!

What are the benefits for Dys persons?

This educational app is equipped with speech recognition and provides translation in English, Chinese, Spanish, French, German, Italian, Japanese and several other languages. It can be used by learners of all age ranges and in all learning settings. It is built to help Dys students and presents several learning outcomes on its web page as well as different formats to choose from. Thanks to this feature, Dys learners can choose what helps them the most.



It is also beneficial for DYS students as it improves their literacy skills by helping them write, check their spelling, acquire and use new vocabulary by providing contextualized explanations. It knows the common mistakes and makes sure the learner understands the rules behind the words' spelling.
